



A. TEANA SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

1. Candidates eligible for the award bursary are:
 - a) Son or daughter and/or grandchildren of an employee of a TEANA member company who is in good standing and has been a member for at least one year.
 - b) Son or daughter and/or grandchildren of a deceased employee of a TEANA member company who is in good standing and has been a member for at least one year.
 - c) A legal ward of an employee of a TEANA member company who is in good standing and has been a member for at least one year.
2. Candidates must have applied for or be enrolled into a full time program at an accredited university or college.
3. Grades, although important, will not be the only criteria used by the evaluating committee. Extra curricular activities and community service will also be heavily weighted.

B. REQUIREMENTS TO ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION FORM

1. An autobiographical essay containing a description of the applicant's:
 - i. Educational objectives
 - ii. Reasons for attending school
 - iii. Commitment to education
 - iv. Post educational goals
 - v. Extra curricular involvement (i.e. Clubs, Spiritual, Internships, Volunteer Work, etc.)
2. A letter of Recommendation from a teacher or faculty member.
3. An official transcript of secondary school grades including, if applicable, mid-term marks of the second semester of the final year.
4. The final date for filling shall be **May 14, 2010**. Materials submitted in support of the Application are not returnable.
